

10.102 DRUG AND ALCOHOL ASSESSMENT / LEVEL OF CARE DETERMINATION

<p>Any individual presenting for drug and alcohol services may receive an assessment / level of care determination. Assessment / Level of Care activities may include any or all of the following:</p> <p>(1) Screening, (2) Assessment, (3) Level of Care recommendation (based on PCPC or ASAM PPC-2), (4) Identification of need for referral to Intensive Case Management and (5) arrangements for placement. These services are provided by the Single County Authority (SCA) or may be contracted to other providers by the SCA.</p>	
<p>Severity of Condition Criteria for Placement</p>	<p>A. Any individual presenting for drug and alcohol services may receive any or all of the services identified below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Screening for the presence of Alcohol and and Other Drug (AOD) Use and special needs considerations. 2. Assessment of the degree, severity and impact on life areas of AOD use. 3. Level of Care recommendation based on (PCPC or Adolescent ASAM PPC-2 or other state approved tool. 4. Identification of need for referral to drug & alcohol Intensive Case Management. 5. Facilitate placement for treatment. <p>B. The individual is at risk or has a substance abuse or addiction disorder.</p>
<p>Intensity of Service and Continued Stay Criteria</p>	<p>Continued stay in a given level of care will be clinically determined by the client's needs as defined by the Pennsylvania Client Placement Criteria or Adolescent ASAM PPC-2 or other state approved tool.</p>
<p>Psychosocial Factors</p>	<p>May be used as relevant to this level of care and as defined by the PCPC or ASAM PPC-2</p>
<p>Exclusion Criteria</p>	<p>Individual chooses not to participate or is unable to complete the assessment.</p>
<p>Discharge Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individual is placed in recommended level of care or alternative level of care. 2. Individual elects not to follow-up with level of care recommendation. 3. Individual's whereabouts become unknown. 4. Individual is incarcerated.
