The purpose of the guide is to help identify appropriate behavioral health services and ancillary services available within Butler County. This guide was prepared primarily for individuals and families residing in Butler County who are members of the HealthChoices Program, the managed care program for individuals who have the Department of Public Welfare Medical Assistance ACCESS card. Members of the HealthChoices Program usually know they are members and have received a Member Handbook from Value Behavioral Health of Pennsylvania (VBH-PA), their managed care organization. Please note that services in the HealthChoices Program depend on eligible individuals receiving Medical Necessity Evaluations for assessment purposes and to determine the appropriate level of care that will best meet their needs. All services listed in the guide are specific to Butler County. Not all services or providers listed may be available in other counties. Likewise, services or providers may be available in other counties that are not available in Butler County.
